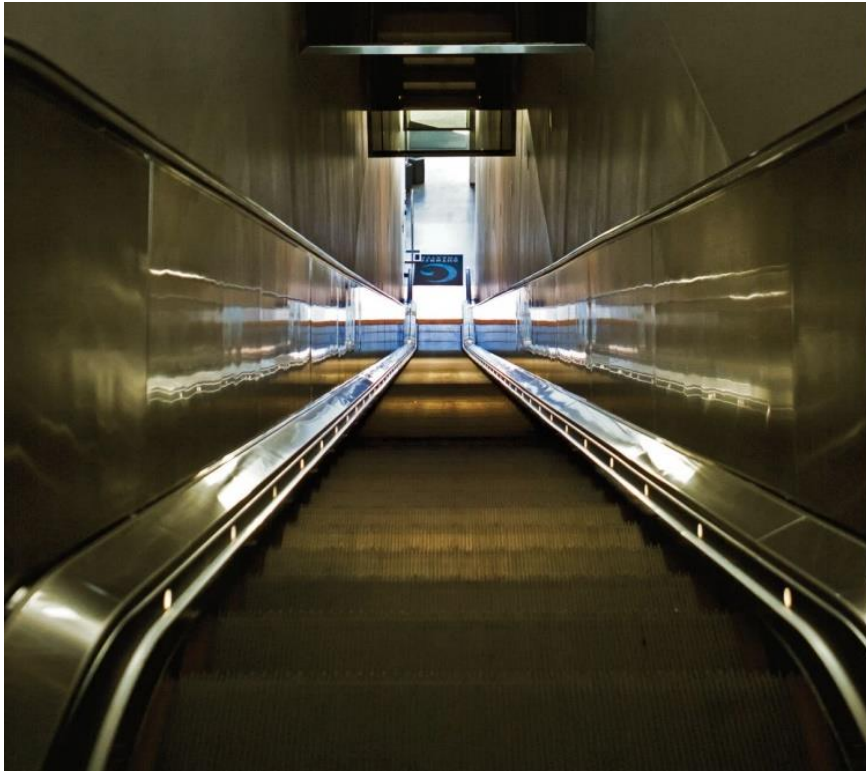

I am attending the book launch party for *I Will Die on This Hill* at the Guthrie Theater in Minneapolis. This event is free to attend.

I can find directions to the theater, parking information, and more in the [Getting to the Guthrie](#) social narrative and the [First-Timer's Guide](#).

Masks are strongly recommended but not required inside the Guthrie Theater.



The party is on the fourth floor of the Guthrie in the Target Lounge. I can get to Level Four via escalator or elevator. There will be signs posted to help me figure out where to go.

There is a performance of *The Little Prince* also scheduled at 7:30 pm this evening.

This means there will be other people in the building trying to get to Level Four.

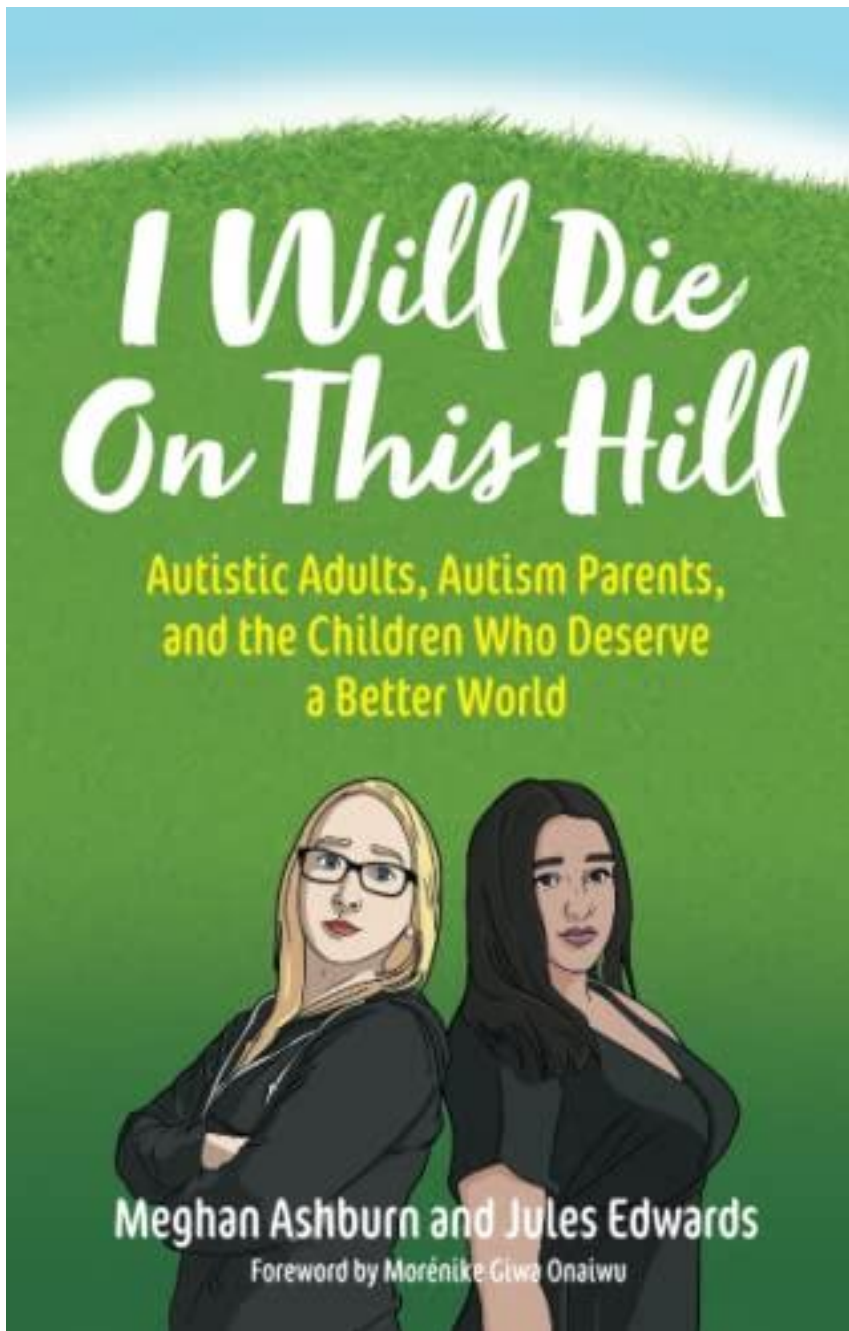
I can plan to arrive early if I want to try to avoid the pre-show crowd.



The doors to the Guthrie will be locked at 8:00 pm. I can still join the party after 8:00 pm by going to the main entrance to the theater and telling Guthrie staff that I am here for the book launch in the Target Lounge.

The event will run from 7:30-9:30 pm, following this approximate schedule:

There will be a limited number of books available to purchase for \$19.99 plus tax (a total of \$21.60). I can pay with cash or credit card.

I do not have to buy a book at the party. This event is a celebration of its release into the world!



There will be snacks to eat for free. I can purchase beverages (including alcohol) at the bar using cash or credit card. I can drink water for free at the drinking fountains in the Level Four lobby near the restrooms.



There are men's, women's, and gender-neutral restrooms located in the Level Four lobby. I can use whatever restroom that matches my gender identity. There will be signs posted directing me where to go as well as describing what kind of toilets, sinks, and hand-drying options to expect.



The party might be crowded and noisy. I can leave the Target Lounge for a break at any time during the event.

There will be a Quiet Area nearby that I can visit, which will have a variety of sensory tools and coloring items.

If I leave the building, I will need to come back in through the main entrance and check in again with Guthrie staff.



When the event ends at 9:30 pm, I will make my way down to Level One via the escalators or elevators. Guthrie staff might remind me to leave the Target Lounge. There may also be patrons from The Little Prince also trying to go downstairs at this time.
